ELECTIONS

November 26th meeting is our month for voting for President, V-President, Secretary and Treasurer... Please speak to someone first before you volunteer their names for any positions.

Positions that are in NEED to be filled are Secretary and Treasurer.

FYI

Anyone can run for any position on the board that is already filled as long as they have agreed to run.

Duties of Officers...

It will be the duty of the **President** to preside at all meetings of the Club and of the Board of Directors and to abide by and enforce the Bylaws of the club.

It shall be the duty of the **Vice President** in the absence of the President to perform all duties incumbent upon the President. The Vice president may fill in for absent Board members or any committee chairman unless already filling in for the President. The Vice President will oversee the "Programs Committee" which will consist of 3-4 people.

The **Secretary** shall keep the records of the membership of the Club and the minutes of the meetings, and those of the Board meetings. Additionally, the Secretary shall be responsible for all other official club correspondence and maintain a copy of all records and the Bulletin, for a period of not less than seven (7) years, which shall be turned over to that person's successor.

The **Treasurer** shall collect all monies and deposit all monies (including dues) in the Club Bank account; and as designated by the Board of Directors; shall pay all bills, keep a correct account of receipts and disbursements. Treasurer shall present an annual written financial report, and, on request, at any business meeting of the Board of Directors shall orally report the receipts and disbursements of the Club, and its financial condition. The Treasurer's books shall be audited at the end of each term of office of the President, Treasurer, or at the discretion of the Board. She/he shall turn over all Club properties in his/her possession to his/her successor when duly installed. The Treasurer or President shall be authorized to disburse funds.
