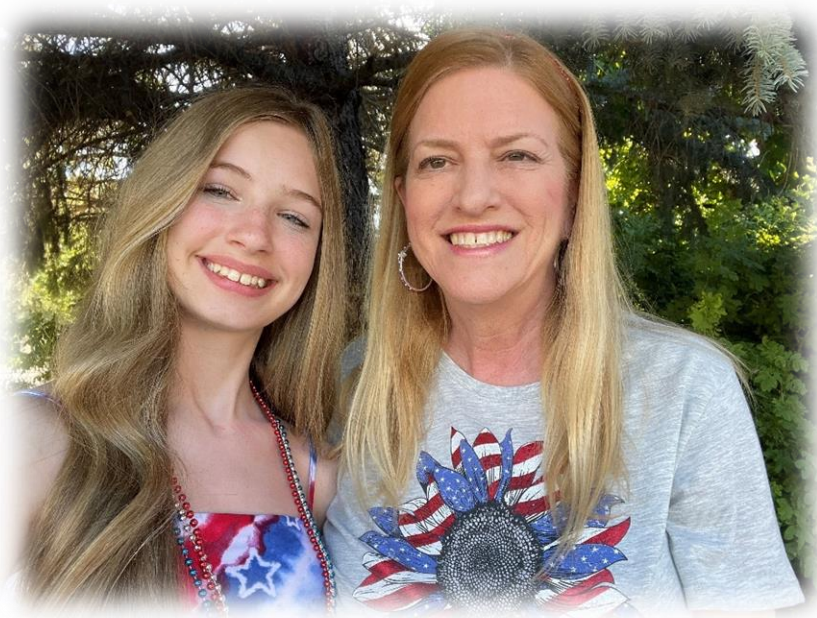

UPCOMING TRIP INFORMATION

July 13th - Salina Agate

The Club will be conducting a field trip on Saturday, July 13th to the Last Chance Road agate field, which is located southeast of Salina, Utah on Interstate 70. Driving time from Ogden to Salina is approximately 3 hours via Interstate 15 south of Nephi to Exit 222, then south on state route 28 into Gunnison where you will take US route 89 south into Salina. From Salina take Interstate 70 east for 35 miles to Exit 91, where you will meet up with Gary and Sally Warren, the trip leaders for the day. The driving time from Salina to Exit 91 is approximately 30 minutes, so when you get to Salina, ensure that you fill up with fuel at one of the stations in town and then proceed to the meeting point at Exit 91, where the group will depart NO LATER THAN (NLT) 11:00 AM. Please allow yourself 4 hours for the one-way trip. It will be a very hot day so make sure you bring plenty of water, lunch, a hat, sunscreen and maybe an umbrella to give yourself some shade. Any vehicle will be able to go on the trip. Gary and Sally Warren will be the lead for this trip, so please let them know if you will be attending. You can call or text them at 435-720-1775. AUGUST 3RD – Santaquin Fossilized Algae

The Club will be conducting a field trip on Saturday, August 3rd, to collect petrified algae south of Santaquin, Utah. Driving time from Ogden to Santaquin is approximately an hour and a half (1 ½) on Interstate 15 south. The group will meet at 10:00 am at the Maverick Gas Station at Exit 244 on Interstate 15 and we will depart for the collection site NO LATER THAN (NLT) 10:30 AM. The collection site is only a couple of miles south of Santaquin. Darrell and Darlene McRoberts will be the lead for this trip, so please let them know if you will be attending. AUGUST 16th – 18th Jackpot, Nevada

The Club will be conducting an overnight weekend field trip to Jackpot, Nevada on Friday, August 16th and returning on Sunday the 18th. We will be collecting all day on Saturday the 17th for petrified wood limb casts, snakeskin agate and paisley agate. Driving time from Ogden to Jackpot is approximately three and a half (3 ½) hours via I-15 north to I-84 west then south on US 93 to Twin Falls, Idaho and then continuing south on US 93 to Jackpot. For those wanting to camp, there is a full hook up RV resort at “Cactus Pete’s Resort Casino” in Jackpot, otherwise hotel accommodations can be made at Cactus Pete’s or at other casinos in Jackpot. Please note, there are no primitive campsites where we will be collecting. The group will meet Saturday morning in the parking lot of the “General Store” which is located directly across the street from “Cactus Pete’s Resort Casino” at 08:30 am (Mountain Time) and we will depart for the collection site NO LATER THAN (NLT) 9:00 AM. The collection site is about an hour drive southeast of Jackpot and some of the roads are only suitable for trucks and SUVs. Darrell and Darlene McRoberts will be the lead for this trip, so please let them know if you will be attending. You can call or text them at 801-317-7001 or 7000. Hope to see you there!
