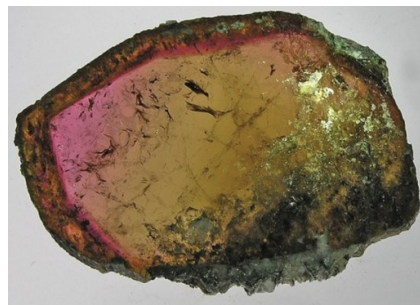

Note from the President

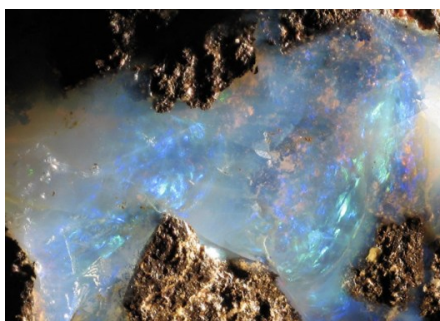

Tourmaline (modern) and Opal (traditional) are the birth stones for October.

Tourmaline is a crystalline silicate mineral which comes in a wide variety of colors. Pink is chosen for October.

Opal is a hydrous silicon dioxide. Without crystalline structure and definite chemical composition (containing a variable amount of water) it is considered a mineraloid. Types of Opals are Fire, Boulder and Common.

If you are interested in running for President, Vice president, Secretary or Treasurer please talk to one of the board members.

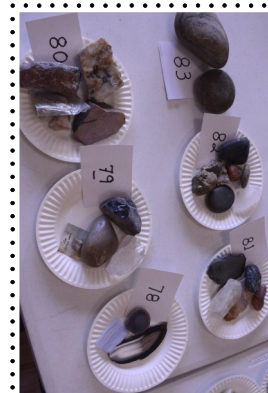
