




## **Note from the President**

16 August - 4 hour drive


Panguich, Utah/Casco Canyon (near Bryce) Agate, Limb Cast

## Agate and Limb Cast Field Trip, September 20th

The Club will be conducting a field trip on Saturday, September 20th, to collect agate and petrified wood limb casts which are located at Casto Canyon and Panguitch Lake. Driving time from Ogden to Panguitch is approximately 4 hours one way.

From Ogden, take I-15 south to Highway 20 east to US 89 south for Panguitch. The rally point for the group will be at "Joe's Main Street Market" which is located on the southwest corner of US 89 and South Main Street in Panguitch. We will meet at 10:00 AM and will depart for the first collection site (Casto Canyon) NO LATER THAN (NLT) 10:30 AM. It is an additional ½ hour drive to the first collection site and the road is accessible to all vehicles.

If you wish to camp for the weekend, here are the coordinates where we will be camping, 37.703867, -112.623917. This site is located 17 miles south of Panguitch on Highway 143 then left on Forest Road 044.

# Wamsutter, Wyoming August 16th -Turritella and Stromatolites Field Trip

The Club will be conducting a field trip on Saturday, August 16th, to collect turritella and stromatolites which are located south of Wamsutter, Wyoming. Driving time from Ogden to the Wamsutter is approximately 3.40 hours one way. It is an additional 40-minutes to the collecting area.

From Ogden, take I-84/80 east to Exit 173 for Wamsutter, Wyoming, which is a 3.40 hour drive. The rally point for the group will be the <u>ONE 9 Gas Station</u> at this exit where we will meet at **10:00 AM** and we will depart for the collection site **NO LATER THAN (NLT) 10:30 AM**. It is an additional 40-minute drive to the collection site and the road is dirt and is accessible to all vehicles.

## July field trip Cedar City BrianHead Agates




























We are getting closer to the Christmas Market that the Beehive Rock and Gem Club will be having in November! So start planning, creating items and getting excited about the event!!
