Start sorting through your rocks and items! Bring your donations to the next club meeting, or hand them off to a board member. Thank you for your support!


We know this year's auction will be a hit—don't miss it!

Henry Mountains, Utah Year End Field Trip Agate, Petrified Wood, Coprolite, Devils Toenails October 9th – 13th

The Club will be conducting our year end field trip on Thursday, October 9th thru October 13th to collect agate, petrified wood, coprolite, and devils' toenails along with other gems that we may find. The camping area is located just outside of Starr Springs Campground with driving time from Ogden being around 5 ½ hours one way. The coordinates for the camping area are 37.848235 -110.656746.

From Ogden, take I-15 south to Highway 6 south at Spanish Fork then to I-70 west to Highway 24 south to Hanksville. At Hanksville, head south on Highway 95 until you get to Highway 276, turn right and continue south to Eggnog Starr Springs Road, turn right. The rally point for the group will be at the camping area outside of Starr Springs Campground. We will meet on Thursday the 9th and begin collecting on Friday morning thru Sunday, with Monday the 13th being a travel day back home.

Please note: There will be a potluck dinner on Saturday evening, so please bring a dish, along with table and chairs. Also, this area is considered a primitive camping site so please make sure you bring everything you need to include extra fuel for your vehicle and remember to stop for fuel in Hanksville before continuing to Starr Springs.

Darrell and Darlene McRoberts will be the lead for this trip, so please let them know if you will be attending. If you do sign up for the trip and then decide not to attend, please call and let them know. Please remember to bring your flag. You can call or text them at 801-317-7001 or 7000.
